RED WINES BY THE GLASS

Loving wine means loving to discover new things about it. Opening a bottle or tasting a new vintage is to be introduced to the roots, tradition and history of a wine. Here at Moo Moo The Wine Bar + Grill, we have taken the dilemma out of choosing the perfect wine by offering a special selection of reds preserved by our 'Enomatic' wine preservation system. The machine prevents the wine from oxidisation by using 'Argon' gas which is activated when a new bottle is installed in the machine.

Coravin is a device which, put simply, allows you to drink a glass of wine without having to pull the cork. It is a 'wine access system' that, whilst taking wine out of a bottle via a medical-grade needle, replaces the resulting air in the bottle with an inert gas, all without damaging the integrity of the cork or the wine itself. Coravin wines are denoted with the symbol ♡

CHAMPAGNE

Champagne is approximately 160 kilometres east of Paris in the country's north east and is centred around the towns of Reims and Epernay where most of the Champagne houses are based. Being one of the northernmost regions in the wine growing world its cooler climate produces high levels of acid which are perfectly suited to the production of sparkling wine but the most significant contribution to the wines of Champagne is made by the soils. A major factor adding to the finesse of the wines is the belemnite chalk subsoil which in most areas sits below a thin layer of surface soil providing excellent drainage as well as moisture retention for the vines. The only three grapes allowed in the production are Pinot Noir which provides structure and weight, Pinot Meunier for middle palate fruit and Chardonnay that gives the wine acidity and elegance.
